We work with several subsector associations that provide specific services for their part of the industry. Members are also required to join their sectoral association (with an additional specific subscription rate).



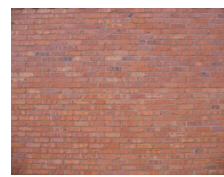
