DEFINITIONS

1. **Net invoice value** means the gross value of sales excluding:
 - value added tax;
 - carriage, insurance and freight on goods sold;
 - trade and cash discounts and rebates;
 - allowances or credits for goods and containers returned or overcharges.

2. **Ceramic products** means
 - any product made wholly or partly of ceramic material including:
 - Household and Ornamental Articles
 - Tiles and Flags
 - Sanitaryware and Sanitary Fixtures
 - Insulators and Insulating Fittings
 - Technical and Advanced Ceramic Products
 - Refractory Products
 - Bricks, Tiles and Construction Products
 - Clay Drainage Pipes
 - Other Ceramic Products of any description

3. **SME (Small or medium-sized enterprise)** as defined by the European Commission is a business or company:
 - that has fewer than 250 employees; and
 - has either (a) annual turnover not exceeding €50 million (approximately £43 million) or (b) an annual balance-sheet total not exceeding €43 million (approximately £37 million).

4. **Relevant period** means the twelve months ending on the last accounting date on or before 31st March, 2020.
